

Pennies A Pound

Choose an airport. Confirm in writing with the Manager.

Apply for Insurance. Mail form to International at least one month before the program.

Recruit Pilots. As soon as possible, send Pilots a letter with the requirements and date for submission. Pilot credentials need to be sent to the FSDO in charge of the airport. The FSDO needs to be informed of the event approx. 1 week to 10 days prior.

Publicity. Print flyers, best to distribute them at the Meetings and on the Website. Handout and put up flyers at local shows and businesses. Hang up Banner where the public will see it clearly. Mail flyers to the local radio stations, newspapers, Girl Scouts, Boy Scout Councils and schools.

Signs need to be put up on the roads leading to the airport a few days before the event.

Establish Chairpersons for Food Committee. Breakfast and lunch is provided for the pilots and volunteers.

Set up a Go/ No Go Weather Committee.

Get supplies: The morning of the event bring along large zip lock bags, paper towels and cleaning fluids. Yellow tape, markers, easel for pilot / weighing area, pens, scales, calculators, hand held radios for all the walkers.

Print up First Flight Certificates. Download from AOPA website.

Print Registration Tickets.

Get at least three large tables and chairs for everyone.

Set up Registration Table. At least 4 people to weigh & fill out Registration tickets and collect the money.

Obtain change in small bills, about \$200.00, in \$1, \$5, and \$10.00 for Cash box.

Set Up Flight Status Board. Need a person to assign passengers to airplanes. Use an Easel Board to match passengers' with airplanes and pilots.

Assign Walkers. At least 2 / pilots to escort passengers to / from the air planes.

Pilot Briefing. Done by a CFI. Pilots need to be briefed before the event on the safety requirements and the air routes which are within 25nm of the airport.
